What is the purpose of BLOOM?

Learning from families to understand how feeding, growth, and caregiver experiences shape growth and development in infants with a cleft.

Who is a good fit for BLOOM?

Caregivers of a baby who has a cleft and is 3 ½ months or younger may be able to take part in BLOOM. Caregivers must speak English or Spanish.

What are caregivers asked to do in the BLOOM study?

1. You will be asked to complete online surveys at three times, which should take 45 - 60 minutes each time.
2. You will be asked to complete monthly check-ins and weight measurements using a provided scale.
3. You will be asked to take 1-time photos of your child's cleft.



Participation will be fully remote.
